

Travel Advisory Update

As part of its efforts against COVID-19, the Government of Jamaica has implemented, with effect 14th March, the following procedures for travellers who have visited the United Kingdom (UK) of Great Britain & Northern Ireland within 14 days of arrival in Jamaica. The announcement was made at a Press Briefing on Friday, 13th March. Jamaican citizens, spouses and persons with permanent residency who have travelled to the UK and the other restricted countries and territories 14 days before will still be landed, but quarantined based on Ministry of Health & Wellness' assessment.

The official list of countries for which Jamaica has, to date, imposed travel restrictions, are, therefore as follows:

The Ministry of Health and Wellness **DOES NOT** recommend non-essential travel at this time. If you do travel to any of these within 14 days of entering Jamaica, you **WILL BE** quarantined at either a government facility or in-home depending on your risk assessment.
